to have and to hold the said Negro boy Tom,

Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, to him and his only proper use and behoof
for ever. And I the said Edward White my Heirs,
Executors, and Administrators, the said bargained Premises unto the said Angus
Martin his Executors, Administrators, and
Assigns, from and against all Persons shall and will warrant, and for ever defend, by
these presents. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal
Dated at Savannah the 29th day of June
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight and in the
twenty-second year of the Independence of the United States of America.
